### PROCEDURE USE & ADHERANCE

- Be sure the procedure if the most current revision
- Ensure everyone involved in the task understands the procedure's overall purpose
- Review all prerequisites, initial conditions, instructions, limits & precautions
- Take the procedure document to the job site with you when required
- Use the procedure according to its designated level of use
- Follow the procedure as written without deviating from its intent
- Ensure that a step is actually complete prior to signing it off

STEPS FOR PLACEKEEPING

Circle the step to be performed

Read the step aloud

Perform the step as written Slash the circle once step is complete

Don't slash the circle until step is complete



- If the step cannot be performed as written
- If injury to workers or damage to equipment will occur if procedure is used as written
- If use of the procedure will result in incorrect or unsafe conditions

- If the procedure is technically incorrect
- If unexpected results are achieved after performing the step
- If the procedure conflicts with another procedure




