## INDUSTRIAL SAFETY

Perform a 2 minute drill every time

Approach every task with the mindset that all accidents are preventable

Always adhere to signage & postings

Use correct PPE & Tools

Review lessons learned and OE when planning work and during pre-job brief

Ensure equipment is safe to work on

STOP when unsure Know your personal limits both mentally & physically and don't try to do more than you should

Comply with chemical requirements

Be alert for changing conditions

Be willing to coach your peers and be open to receiving coaching from others

Positively recognize safe practices

Store tools & equipment properly

Maintain good housekeeping to avoid additional hazards being created in the work area

Verify all fire doors are latched

Be responsible for your own safety and the safety of your co-workers


