YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION

Your address, phone number & email address need to be kept up to date with the home office. If you have renewed your DL, you need to provide us with a copy of your new DL. We use this info to submit you as authorized workers to the plants, so it is imperative our records match your current DL. Not having this info up to date could slow down your badging/in-processing.

YOUR VEHICLE, BACKPACK & <u>LUNCHBOX</u>

Before you pack up for the new season, please be sure to check your vehicle, backpack and lunch box for items that are not permitted on site. Weapons, ammo, alcohol & contraband will all land you in hot water if they are found in your possession. Be sure to preform a self check before the season commences and each day on the job, to be sure you haven't put something that isn't permitted in your bag or vehicle.

PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT

If you are an ongoing outage worker with Merrick, then you should retain your hardhat from job to job and season to season. If you need a new hardhat for the upcoming season, please contact Mike Abboud. You also need steel toe or composite boots that are in good condition. Merrick provides gloves and safety glasses on site.

DRUG & ALCOHOL TESTING

During in-processing, you will be tested for drugs & alcohol. You are subsequently expected to adhere to the FFD program and be prepared for random testing at any point on any given day. If you carry prescription medications with you to site, you must keep them in the prescription bottle. You may not combine multiple medications into one bottle for convenience.

We are thrilled to announce that we have been awarded two new contracts for the Spring season.

In March, we will be sending a maintenance crew of 17 to Vogtle Nuclear Plant in Waynesboro, GA. Vogtle currently has two operating units and have units 3 & 4 under construction. These will be the first new units to be moved into operation in the U.S. in over 30 years!! In May, we will be sending a maintenance crew of 13 and an eddy current crew of 31 to Columbia Generating Station in Richland, WA. Columbia currently has a single operating unit.

These new contracts are wonderful opportunities for us to continue to grow our customer base and to support individual growth of our technicians. We are excited to send some of our best and brightest to support these outages!!



The U.S. Dept. Of Energy released a major study in September 2022, that found that 80% of U.S. coal power plants evaluated could be converted to nuclear power plants.
