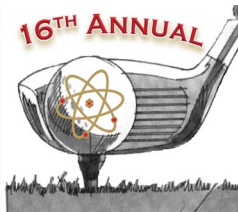

VEHICLE SAFETY

All personnel operating a company vehicle are obligated to conduct a thorough inspection prior to any vehicle being brought on site at any facility including physically viewing the condition of the vehicle and the safety of the anticipated vehicle path.

All vehicle occupants shall wear seatbelts, at all times when the vehicle motor is running and when the vehicle is moving.

Trucks, vehicles and equipment exceeding 11,000 LB shall use wheel chocks when parked.

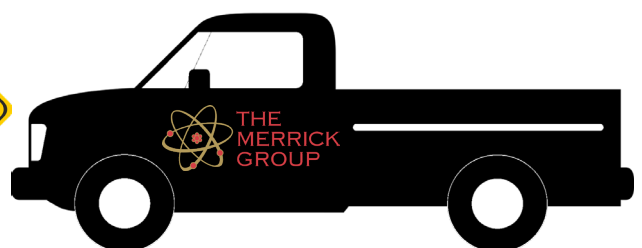
All vehicles shall be shut off during refueling.

The use of cell phones or computers is prohibited unless the vehicle is in park.

All vehicles' registration and inspection shall be up to date, at all times. Current insurance card shall be kept in the vehicle at all times.

Keys shall be removed from the vehicle prior to it being left on site. The vehicle shall be locked at all times when left on site. All trailers shall be locked at all times while in motion and while left on site.

All vehicles shall be cleaned out upon return to the shop leaving no trash, PPE, or tools behind.
